

FARGODOME SALES TAX

MEASURE #1

Shall the city of Fargo's Home Rule Charter be amended to establish a onequarter of one percent (1/4%) sales, use and gross receipts tax to extend for twenty (20) years with the funds collected from said tax to be utilized for costs associated with the remodeling of the Fargodome and with ongoing capital improvements, maintenance and operations of the Fargodome, as provided in the Notice of Proposed Home Rule Charter Amendment as published in THE FORUM on the 28th day of August, 2024.

Remodel of the existing 30-year-old building to include alignment with current codes, enhancements to better meet patron expectations of a modern entertainment facility and improvements to address operational efficiencies.

Funds to use from FARGODOME Escrow Account: Approximately 70% of current \$43+ million balance

Years of proposed tax: 20-YEAR 1/4 CENT CITY OF FARGO SALES TAX

Current sales tax (2024): 7.5% (5% STATE + 2% CITY + .5% COUNTY)

Proposed sales tax: 7.75% (5% STATE + 2.25% CITY + .5% COUNTY)

\$100 invoice = 1 quarter \$10,000/YR = \$25/YR

REVENUE FROM NON-LOCAL PATRONS OF FARGODOME: 55%

WHAT WILL THIS VOTE MEAN?

1. Additional Restrooms

95% more women's and 43% more men's restrooms will be added.

2. Enhanced Seating & Seats

All stadium seats will be updated along with the addition of cup holders. Overall seating capacity will remain the same with enhanced club levels and the addition of new suites.



The improved FARGODOME will further enhance existing accessible seating options.

4. Build on what's working
